Update to Newport Dock, Bellmouth and Cardiff Wrach Channel Dredging Campaign

Beginning on or around Friday 10th July 2020 for a period of 5 days the UKD Orca will be carrying out dredging work in the Cardiff Wrach Channel area.

Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to the port of Cardiff.

Beginning on or around Tuesday 14th July 2020 for a period of 5 days the UKD Sealion will be carrying out dredging work in the Newport Dock and Bellmouth area. Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to the port of Newport.

Beginning on or around Friday 17th July 2020 for a period of 5 days the UKD Orca will be carrying out dredging work in the Newport Dock area. Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to the port of Newport.

The vessels will display lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16, 71 and 68.
