CONSTRUCTION OF NEW LIFEBOAT STATION – MUMBLES PIER

Notice is hereby given that on the 2-08-2012 works will begin to construct the new Life Boat Station On Mumbles Pier in Swansea for a period of 64 weeks.

Project: New Lifeboat Station Mumbles
Client: RNLI

The works will be serviced from a Jackup barge for the first 40 weeks called the Sea Riser 2 which will remain on station. Supply of materials to and from the works will be from APB Swansea by the Glenesk tug and flat top barge JML 35 and a landing craft called the Severn Sins. The vessels will display light and shapes in accordance with the international regulations for the prevention of collision at sea.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the construction works and keep clear of the Pier over this period.
