### PURPOSE BUILT VESSEL TRANSITING FROM BARRY HARBOUR TO PORTISHEAD VIA CARDIFF BAY AND THE RIVER USK

All Mariners please be advised that as part of an historical re-enactment of the transport of blue stone from Wales to Stonehenge, a purpose built vessel will be transiting from Barry Harbour to Portishead via Cardiff Bay and The River Usk.

The Vessel is approximately 40 foot long and will be rowed by a team of 10 men.

This re-enactment is expected to take place between the 21<sup>st</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> August 2012 during daylight hours.

All Mariners are requested to keep a sharp lookout for this vessel and to give it a wide berth at all times.
