MOMENTIVE SPECIALITY CHEMICALS - DYE TEST

Momentive Speciality Chemicals are looking to undertake a dye test on their sea main section running from the tidal flap at the Bendricks out to sea. They will look to get access to the line via Spartan on the Atlantic industrial estate and be working on the seaward side of the tidal flap bridge.

The work will involve transferring 20 tonnes of dye from a road barrel into the line at the tidal flap area and then monitoring the foreshaw during the normal pumping process. It is planned to undertake this work on the 14th November at low tide ~ 12.45.

The dye is green in colour and should be visible 1km out to sea for 10 to 15 minutes before it disperses.
