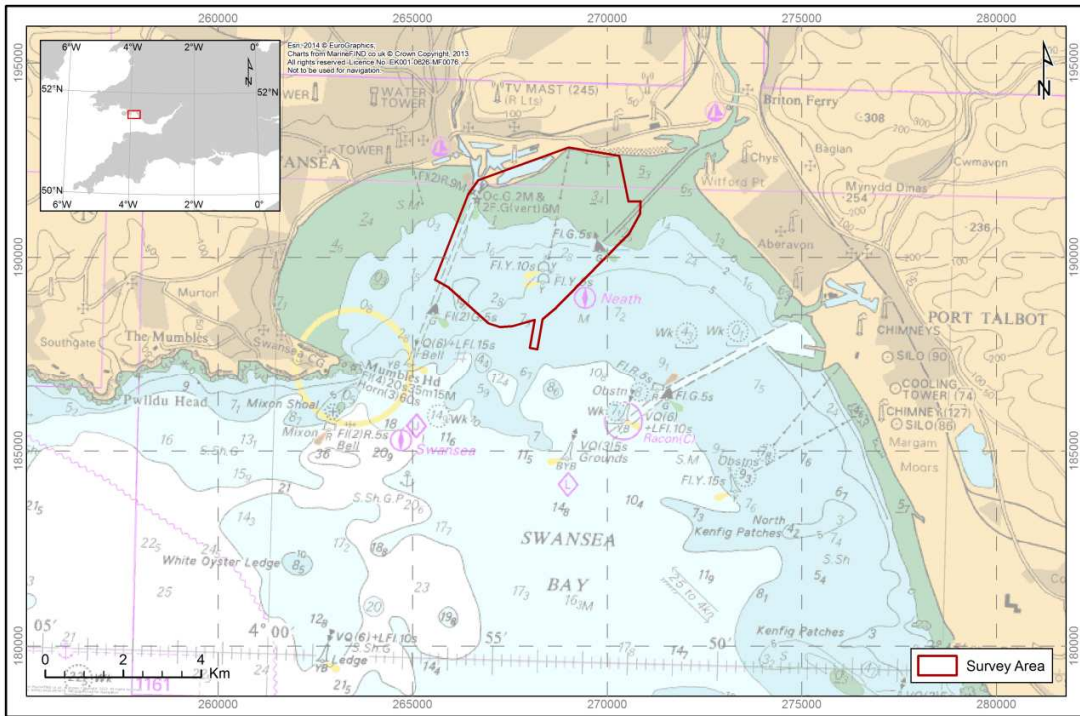


Figure 1 Survey extents

Figure 1 attached shows the extents of the survey area and co-ordinates in which the vessel will be operating.

Vessel:

Valkyrie (Call Sign 2BWA9) is a built 12m Catapult Catamaran with a 1.07m draft. She is coded to MCA work boat CAT 2. The vessel will be operating on a 12 hour basis.

The vessel will operate with a range of hull mounted at towed equipment and will have restricted manoeuvrability. Throughout survey operations the vessel will be displaying the appropriate lights and shapes as required under the COLREGS rule 27 (b) and will require other vessels to maintain a wide berth of at least 100 m where practical and safe to do so.
