## **MOMENTIVE SPECIALITY CHEMICALS – DYE TEST - BARRY**

Mariners are advised that Momentive Speciality Chemicals are planning to undertake a dye test on their sea main section running from the tidal flap at the Bendricks out to sea. They will gain access to the line via the Atlantic industrial estate and be working on the seaward side of the tidal flap bridge.

The work will involve transferring 20 tonnes of dye from a road barrel into the line at the tidal flap area and then monitoring the foreshore during the normal pumping process. The work is planned for 25<sup>th</sup> September at low tide ~ 14.30. The dye is green in colour and should be visible 1km out to sea for 10 to 15 minutes before it disperses.
