#### Swansea Bay – Seabed Sited Instrumentation

**General** - As part of the metocean data gathering survey work associated with the proposed Tidal lagoon in Swansea Bay, SECAMS will be deploying maintaining seabed based scientific equipment at six sites in the area.

The instrumentation will be sited on the seabed and connected to a ground-line which will in turn connect to a mooring weight. The mooring weight anchors the surface mark.
