NEWPORT CHANNEL STEMMING

With immediate effect, the way that vessels are now stemmed for any port will now be with regard to their Under Keel Clearance (UKC) in relation to the water in the channel/approach.

At present Newport Channel limiting depth has been set at +0.7m

For stemming purposes 0.7m should be added to the ships draft on a flood tide and 1.5m should be added on an ebb tide.
