## LEGISLATION UPDATES: DANGEROUS GOODS IN HARBOUR AREAS REGULATIONS 2016, AND CONTAINER WEIGHT VERIFICATION

Colleagues,

You are asked to note the following updates to legislation.

## Dangerous Goods in Harbour Areas Regulations 2016 - update

Following the HSE consultation on the review and update of the Dangerous Substances in Harbour Areas Regulations 1987 (DSHAR) which was completed on 23 December 2015, the process of agreeing the proposals with ministers for the new Dangerous Substances in Harbour Areas Regulations 2016 (DGHAR) has been completed.

The Dangerous Goods in Harbour Areas Regulations 2016 have now been laid in parliament and will take effect on 1 October subject to parliamentary scrutiny. DGHAR modernises and simplifies DSHAR, removing redundant and superseded sections while retaining proportionate protections.

A new Approved Code of Practice has also been developed to support DGHAR, the draft DGHAR ACOP is now available on the HSE webpage at <a href="http://hse.gov.uk/pubns/books/l155.htm">http://hse.gov.uk/pubns/books/l155.htm</a>. The final ACOP will be published by 1 October.

## Verification of container weights

The DfT has requested that harbour masters and all port users are reminded of the obligation on shippers to verify the gross mass of packed containers, effective since 1 July 2016 under the amendment to SOLAS VI Regulation 2.
