Please ensure that all cyclists are aware that this is a dangerous practice that should not be undertaken. It is a requirement for bicycles to have correctly functioning front and rear lights. It is recommended that the appropriate PPE is worn when cycling.

Cyclists are also reminded of the requirement to dismount at rail crossing points and that bicycles should not be used in operational areas.

Please be advised that ABP and its security contractor reserve the right to refuse entry onto the port to anyone considered to be unsafe and a danger to themselves and other road users.
