Upgrade of rock revetment at Swansea Bay campus

A 150m section of existing coastal protection at the Bay university campus is to be Upgraded and this will require the temporary use of the adjacent foreshore for stockpiling material and for machine work. The works will use the existing rock and a significant quantity of additional rock will be imported to complete the defence. The working area will be high in the tidal ladder and above the mean high water mark. The works are located adjacent to Crymlyn burrows between the ports of Swansea and Neath. Works are planned to take place between mid July and through to November 2017.
