Port Talbot, Swansea, Cardiff and Newport Dredging Campaign

Mariners are advised that the following vessels will be conducting dredging campaigns on the dates and in the ports stated below. Mariners are advised to be aware and take extra caution when on their approach to the ports of Swansea, Port Talbot, Cardiff and Newport.

- UKD Orca – Swansea and Port Talbot channels – Tuesday June 15th 2021 for 4 days
- UKD Cherry Sand – Swansea and Port Talbot channels – Tuesday June 22nd 2021 for 8 days
- UKD Sealion – Swansea and Port Talbot channels – Saturday June 26th 2021 for 4 days
- UKD Orca – Newport Channel – Friday June 18th 2021 for 10 days
- UKD Sealion – Newport Channel – Thursday July 1st 2021 for 6 days
- UKD Orca – Cardiff Channel – Wednesday June 30th 2021 for 5 days

The vessels will display lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16,14,12,68 and 71.
