## **CYCLISTS ON PORT ESTATES.**

With the onset of darker mornings and evenings, there have been several recent reports of cyclists observed without lights. Please ensure that all cyclists are aware that this is a dangerous practice that should not be undertaken. It is a requirement for bicycles to have correctly functioning front and rear lights. It is also <u>recommended</u> that the appropriate PPE is worn when cycling (high visibility clothing and helmets).

Cyclists are also reminded of the requirement to dismount at rail crossing points and that bicycles should not be used in operational areas.

Please be advised that ABP and its security contractor reserve the right to refuse entry onto the port to anyone considered to be unsafe and a danger to themselves and other road users.
