THE SWANSEA (CLOSURE OF PRINCE OF WALES DOCK) HARBOUR REVISION ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Swansea (Closure of Prince of Wales Dock) Harbour Revision Order 2022 was made by the Welsh Ministers on 24 May 2022 and comes into force on 26 May 2022.

**HARBOURS ACT 1964 (AS AMENDED)
CLOSURE OF PRINCE OF WALES DOCK, SWANSEA**

Following the making of the Swansea (Closure of Prince of Wales Dock) Harbour Revision Order 2022 (“the Order”) by the Welsh Ministers on 24 May 2022 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that:

- (1) Associated British Ports (A.B. Ports) intends to close the Prince of Wales Dock from 5 July 2022 and from that date:
 - (a) the Prince of Wales Dock ceases to form part of the Port of Swansea;
 - (b) all duties and obligations imposed on AB Ports under the Swansea Harbour Acts 1874 – 1901 with respect to or in connection with the Prince of Wales Dock are to cease;
 - (c) any and all rights of navigation within the Prince of Wales Dock are extinguished; and
 - (d) any and all duties or obligations to maintain a navigable channel to the Prince of Wales Dock within the area shown hatched blue on the Prince of Wales Dock plan or to maintain a swing bridge across that area are extinguished.
- (2) all vessels must be removed from the Dock by 12 July 2022.
